- **Example:** A box measuring 12â³ x 10â³ x 8â³ has a DIM weight of:

- **Weigh the Package:** Use a scale to determine the actual weight.
- **Use the Higher Value:** Carriers charge based on the greater of DIM weight or actual weight.

Step 2: Choose a Shipping Carrier and Service Level

Compare rates from different carriers based on:

• **Delivery Speed:** Overnight, 2-day, ground, or economy.

• **Destination:** Domestic vs. international.

Per-Unit Shipping Cost: \$205.20 / 100 phones = **\$2.05 per phone.**
