- **Face ID & Secure Enclave** Biometric authentication ensures only you can authorize payments.
- **Global Compatibility** Works with most NFC terminals worldwide.

Downside: Limited to Apple Pay (no Google Pay or Samsung Pay).

2. Samsung Galaxy S24 Ultra

Best for: Android users who want Samsung Pay, Google Pay, and MST (Magnetic Secure Transmission) support

Samsung's flagship **Galaxy S24 Ultra** is one of the best Android phones for contactless payments, offering **three payment options**:

3. Google Pixel 8 Pro

5. Xiaomi 14 Ultra

- **Mi Pay & Google Pay** Supports multiple digital wallets.

- **Dual-Frequency GPS & UWB** Useful for location-based payments and digital keys.

Downside: Mi Pay is not as widely accepted as Google Pay or Apple Pay in some regions.

6. Sony Xperia 1 V

Best for: Privacy-focused users with secure NFC payments
