4. Agree to the **Parent Privacy Disclosure**.
5. Confirm the **payment method** for the child's account.

Step 4: Choose Shared Features

After adding family members, you can enable:

• **Purchase Sharing** (share apps, music, movies, etc.)

• **Location Sharing** (via Find My)

• **Screen Time** (for parental controls)

• **iCloud Storage** (200GB or 2TB plans)

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Troubleshooting Common Issues

1. Invitation Not Received?

- Check **Spam/Junk** folders in the recipient's email.
- Ensure the **correct Apple ID email** was used.
- Resend the invite from **Settings > [Your Name] > Family Sharing**.

2. Payment Method Declined?

- Verify the **payment method** is valid.
- Update the **billing address** in **Settings > [Your Name] > Payment & Shipping**.
- Try a different **credit/debit card or PayPal**.

3. Child Account Not Working?

- Ensure the child's **Apple ID is correctly set up**.
- Check **Screen Time restrictions** (Settings > Screen Time).
- Verify **Ask to Buy** is enabled for the child.

4. Can't Share Certain Purchases?

- Some apps, in-app purchases, or subscriptions **cannot be shared**.
 - Check the **App Store** for Family Sharing compatibility.
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Best Practices for Family Sharing

- **Use a shared iCloud storage plan** (200GB or 2TB) to avoid individual storage limits.
- **Enable Ask to Buy** for children to approve purchases.
