1. iPhone 13 Mini (Best Overall for One-Handed Use)

Screen Size: 5.4 (Super Retina XDR OLED)

Weight: 140g

Dimensions: 131.5 x 64.2 x 7.65mm

Why It's Great for One-Handed Typing:

Compact size The smallest flagship smartphone in recent years, making it perfect for one-handed use.

Excellent grip The flat-edge design and lightweight build ensure a secure hold.

iOS Reachability Mode Double-tap the Home indicator (or swipe down on the bottom edge for Face ID models) to bring the top of the screen within thumb reach.

Floating keyboard Third-party apps like **Gboard** allow resizing the keyboard for one-handed typing.

Haptic feedback The tactile response makes typing feel more precise.

Downsides:

Battery life is weaker than larger iPhones.

No high-refresh-rate display (60Hz only).

2. Asus Zenfone 10 (Best Android for One-Handed Typing)

4. Google Pixel 7a (Best Mid-Range Option)

 - **CAT S22 Flip** A **flip phone** with a **small external screen** for quick one-handed typing.
